27th Annual Cayman Carnival Batabano Costume Street Parade Rules & Guidelines of Adult Parade – Saturday 1st May, 2010

REGISTRATION:

1. No Band or individual will be allowed to participate in the Costume Street Parade without formal registration with the Cayman Carnival Batabano Committee (“CCB”). All bands must register utilising the CCB Registration Form and pay the appropriate registration fee – deadline **Friday 16th April 2010**.
2. Vehicle Registration Numbers **must** be included within the CCB Registration Form. Each band, with up to 100 participants, will be permitted a maximum of **two** refreshment trucks and **one** music truck. Each band, with over 100 participants, will be permitted a maximum of **two** refreshments trucks and **two** music trucks. Only non-alcoholic branded vehicles will be permitted to take part in the Parade.
3. Costumes formerly used in any Batabano Costume Street Parade may be used again, but will not be eligible to be judged.
4. In the event that there is only one King or Queen entry for the parade, no prizes will be awarded.
5. All Bands are required to provide the CCB Committee with details of their designated Head Marshall no later than **23rd April, 2010**.
6. All Bands registered **must** have a representative together with their Head Marshall at the **Mandatory Road Conduct** briefing to be held at Reliable Industries on **22nd April @ 5:30 pm Sharp!** At this meeting a drawing for Band positions will take place and permits issued for those vehicles registered with CCB. Band leaders who miss this meeting will be placed in a position determined by the CCB Committee. Any vehicle not displaying the CCB permit will not be able to participate in the Costume Street Parade.

PARADE LINE UP & CONDUCT

7. The assembly point will be outside the Marquee Cinema. All Band vehicles must be assembled in ready positions @ 1.30 pm on **1st May, 2010**. Vehicles arriving after this time will lose their position and will be placed at the rear of the Parade. Masqueraders should be ready to start the Parade @ **3:00 pm Sharp!**



8. In order to assist judging, each Band must be headed by a banner/placard clearly identifying their group. Masqueraders should be positioned at all times behind their designated banner / placard.
9. In order to assist the flow of the Parade, Band Marshalls **must** ensure that there are no large gaps. All Band Marshalls will be identified by wearing the t-shirts purchased from the Cayman Carnival Batabano Committee. Each band, with up to 50 participants will be required to have a minimum of 2 Band Marshalls (inclusive of their Head Marshall). Each band, with between 51 and 100 participants will be required to have a minimum of 6 Band Marshalls (inclusive of their Head Marshall). Each band, with over 100 participants will be required to have a minimum of 10 Band Marshalls (inclusive of their Head Marshall).
10. **All Masqueraders must be of a minimum age of 18 years** and should be attired in costume or Band t-shirt(s). All Bands that include a T-shirt section are to ensure that masqueraders are provided with additional 'carnival type' items e.g. beads, masks, flags or a head piece. No person under the age of 18 years is permitted to participate in the Parade.
11. There should be **NO** form of association with "*playing*" **mud, paint, or the spraying of any form of liquid** on the watching audience by any Band in the parade. Public defacement of property in any form, for example graffiti, paint, mud etc will not be tolerated. Individuals in violation of this rule will be requested to leave the Parade by any official CCB Marshall or the Police.
12. The public display of alcohol will not be tolerated. Individuals in violation of this rule will be requested to leave the Parade by any Marshall or Police.
13. Sponsors names / logos can be displayed on t-shirts, registered vehicles, banners and placards of any size. Sponsors' names / logos associated with alcoholic beverages, products and/or suppliers can be displayed in similar fashion but the size of their name / logo must be restricted to no larger than 18 square feet; feather flags displaying these types of logos can be no larger than 10' x 2'. No Band is to display any political affiliations within the Parade.
14. Each Band Leader is responsible for the conduct of their band and are required to ensure lawful conduct and strict adherence to the Rules & Guidelines of the Costume Street Parade.
15. Each Band and its members are **required to maintain decorum** throughout the parade route and **any visible display of alcohol, public indecency or unlawful conduct may result in the individual being removed from the Parade** by the Cayman Islands Police Service, point(s) deduction and or disqualification from judging or participating in any future CCB event.
